

UMC Special Offerings for 2022

- **(G) Human Relations Day** - January 9, 2022 [*This offering supports Community Development, UM Voluntary Service, and Youth Offender Rehabilitation programs*]
- **(NGA) Homeless Offering** - February 27, 2022 [*Provides both operational and capital grants to help churches and other non-profit organizations in ministering to very poor and homeless persons throughout our Conference.*]
- **(G) One Great Hour of Sharing** - March 27, 2022 [*Provides major support of the UM Communities of Relief (UMCOR), which provides immediate assistance in the wake of disasters and helps support ongoing ministries of food, shelter, health, and peace.*]
- **(G) Native American Ministries Sunday** - April 17, 2022 [*Funds urban ministries with Native Americans Scholarships for Native Americans attending United Methodist seminaries and annual conference Native American ministries.*]
- **(NGA) Mother's Day Offering** - May 8, 2022 [*Support Wesley Woods, which serves the health and housing needs of older adults at 9 communities throughout North Georgia. The offering helps cover the cost of health care, meals, and wellness programs for low-income residents.*]
- **(G) Peace with Justice Sunday** - May 15, 2022 [*supports peace with justice ministries through the General Board of Church and Society and the annual conferences; such as after-school care and summer camps, as well as counseling for neighborhood children.*]
- **(NGA) Annual Conference Appeal** - June 5, 2022 [*Each year churches across the Conference collect a special offering to meet a direr humanitarian need somewhere in North Georgia or around the world that is shared at the Annual Conference session.*] (The June 2021 offering went to Ministerial Education Fund; this fund helps pay tuition & other cost for future clergy.)
- **(NGA) Murphy-Harpst** - July 17, 2022 [*This offering helps Murphy-Harpst transform the lives of Georgia's abused and neglected children through loving, Christian care and personalized treatment programs.*]
- **(NGA) Golden Cross** - August 21, 2022 [*These funds are administered by the Conference Health and Welfare Committee to provide assistance to persons who are experiencing financial difficulty due to excessive medical expenses.*]
- **(NGA) Well Root Family Services (formally the United Methodist Children's Home Work Day Offering)** - September 18, 2022 [*Provides redemptive, healing services that bring meaningful change to the lives of children and families.*]
- **(G) World Communion Sunday** - October 2, 2022 [*Supports Word Scholarships, the Ethnic Scholarship Program, and the Ethnic In-Service Training Program.*]
- **(NGA) Aldersgate/Collinswood** - October 23, 2022 [*Serves persons with developmental disabilities by assisting adults in securing safe, affordable, comfortable residential placements. Aldersgate also operates Collinswood, a universally accessible retreat facility.*]
- **(G) United Methodist Student's Day** - November 27, 2022 [*Provides loan and scholarship funds for United Methodist college, university, and graduate students.*]
- **(G) Aids Awareness** - December 4, 2022 [*Provides the tools and expertise to help churches address health awareness, concerns, and education.*]
